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Services and Locations



The Oakleaf Group offer a range of specialist services designed to meet the needs of adult males with complex neurological conditions and brain injury. All services are supported by our highly skilled and experienced multi-disciplinary team providing a flexible and seamless rehabilitation pathway.

Referrals can be made to the service by using the online referral form via our website or contacting the main site directly. Assessments are offered free of charge and referrers will receive a comprehensive report with detailed findings, recommendations and initial goal setting expectations. Our services are able to accommodate those on Section 17 Leave of the Mental Health Act and those on Community and Guardianship Orders.

The large multi-disciplinary team consists of a wide range of healthcare specialists and effective interdisciplinary working is paramount to the development and success of the individual programmes of care. We benefit from 'on-site' 24 hour nursing (RMN, RNLD and RGN) which enables the service to accommodate more complex nursing needs including Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy (PEG) feed, tracheostomy, palliative care and end of life care. Other on-site specialisms include Neuropsychiatry, Neuropsychology, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Speech & Language Therapy, Rehabilitation Assistants, Family Liaison Team, Horticultural Therapy and access to a dedicated GP service for all residents.

Comprehensive assessment reports are provided at the end of each assessment period and detail progress on individual identified goals and recommendations on future care pathway planning.

The Oakleaf Group provide services from three areas within Northampton, these are:

Main Site

Ashton Road, Hartwell, Northampton, NN7 2EY

Each of these services focus on providing active rehabilitation. Developed by the specialist team, all residents will have in place their unique care programme focusing on short and long terms goals. Sessions are meaningful, reflect individual needs and incorporate each persons' personal interests. All of these services are able to accommodate residents with complex physical health needs in addition to their needs around cognitive and behavioural rehabilitation. All facilities are available to all residents within the group as appropriate.

Mosley Lodge



4 bedded specialist environment able to accommodate males requiring a higher level of behaviour intervention and management, incorporating strategies and modification programmes to ensure safety of self and others. The aim is for residents to be able to enter other locations within the service allowing greater access to a wider range of therapies.

Mosley House



9 bedded unit (5 ground floor and 4 first floor). Ground floor rooms are able to accommodate wheelchair users and more ambulant residents are able to use the first floor accommodation. All bedrooms are en-suite and communal facilities include quiet room with TV facilities, access to dedicated session rooms, gym and extensive gardens.

Cunningham House



14 bedded unit, single-storey able to accommodate wheelchair users - 3 bedrooms fitted with ceiling track hoists. All bedrooms have wet-room en-suites and communal facilities include large lounge and dining rooms, pool room, gym, session rooms and access to extensive gardens. Cunningham House also provides 4 flats for residents who are ready to begin living a little more independently with the supervision and guidance of the nursing and therapy team.

Orchard House



22 bedded unit, single-storey able to accommodate wheelchair users - 9 bedrooms fitted with ceiling track hoists. All bedrooms have wet-room en-suites and communal facilities include 2 lounges and dining areas, sports hall, Snoezelen (multi-sensory room), dedicated session rooms and access to extensive gardens.

Community

Each of these services are located in the heart of the community allowing residents to enjoy a greater level of easy access to community activities that meet their needs and interests. Residents are supported by dedicated 24 hour support staff together with the specialist multi-disciplinary team who work closely with residents to develop care programmes that build on the skills and abilities already gained through structured active rehabilitation. Community placements allow residents to safely 'test out' their abilities using local education and vocational facilities, giving them the opportunity to live a more independent life. Residents will still require a level of support from specific therapies which is accessed both on-site from therapists located in the community and if required those located at the main site.

Hunsbury House



5 bedded community home set in a residential area with easy access to local transport and nearby leisure, education and vocational opportunities. All bedrooms are en-suite and residents enjoy large communal kitchen and living areas with relaxing garden/patio areas.

Martins Court



Two neighbouring properties in the heart of a village location with easy access to public transport and local leisure facilities. Each home can accommodate up to 5 residents in each and both benefit from en-suite bedrooms and high spec shared living

St Peters Gardens



Also located within a village location, this community home can accommodate 3 residents, each with their own en-suite bedroom and enjoy comfortable shared kitchen and living facilities.

The Cotswolds

178 Cotswold Avenue, Duston, Northampton, NN5 6DS



The Cotswolds service is set in tranquil grounds in the heart of the main village of Duston. With 24 hour specialised qualified nursing the service is able to accommodate residents who are requiring a specialist environment to manage more complex health and nursing needs such as Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy (PEG) feed and tracheostomy care. The Cotswolds are also extremely proud to have recently been awarded the "Gold Standard" in the delivery of End of Life and Palliative Care to its residents and their families by the Gold Standards Framework.

Typically residents at The Cotswolds will have undergone a period of active rehabilitation and have reached a point where focus now is more about managing the progress they have made and ensuring that their quality of life is as full and meaningful as can be. Programmes of care remain individualised and unique to their interests and also have access to the wider therapy team based on the main site.
